






Program Funding Breakdown

5310

- Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program
 - Federal Funds
 - 50% Match Required

 Main source of funds and main program we use for transporting clients

How we use 5310

- Pays for:
 - Transportation of Clients
- We create a rate to cover all of the cost of transporting those clients.

We charge that rate for every ride

- Rate we charge clients includes cost of:
 - Driver Salaries
 - Operational Staff Salaries (dispatchers, schedulers, operations supervisors)
 - Fuel
 - Maintenance

"The cost of doing business"



5311 - Admin

- Rural Area Formula Program
 - Federal Funds
 - 15% Match Required

Main source of funds for administering the system and various funding streams

How we use 5311 - Admin

- Pays for:
 - Admin staff and Director staff
 - Other Direct Charges (software, travel, office supplies)



5311 - Capital

- Rural Area Formula Program
 - Federal Funds
 - 10% Match Required

Main source for Capital purchases

How we use 5311 - Capital

- Pays for:
 - Replacement Vehicles
 - Outfitting Vehicles
 - Propane Conversion
 - Camera Systems
 - Tablets




ROAP

- Rural Operating Assistance Program
 - State Funds
 - 0% Match Required
 - Formula Based Allocation (each category has a different formula)
- Three Funding Categories
 - EDTAP (Elderly and Disabled Transportation Assistance Program)
 - EMPL (Employment and Transportation Assistance Program)
 - RGP (Rural General Public Program)



ROAP Funding Distribution



How we use ROAP

- Pays for:
 - Transportation of Clients

- At the same rate we use for 5310 transportation
- Funding never lasts full fiscal year
 - Clients can fit in multiple categories so we are strategic in how we assign the ride



ConCPT - CO


- Coordination for Regional Service Program
 - State Funds
 - 50% match
- Enhance coordination between NCDOT IMD Grantees
- Must include at least 3 systems
- Routes should provide access to major medical and regional transportation facilities



How we use ConCPT-CO



- Pays for:
 - Down East Express
- Daily trips to the Triangle Area
- Rates vary by county
- Use revenue from these rides to cover match for this grant





RO

- Rural State Operating
 - State Funds
 - 0% match
 - Normally aren't eligible (one time thing)

 Assist in delivering important transit service beyond that which is supported by federal formula funding programs.

How we use RO

- Pays for:
 - Carteret Correctional Center Work Release Program

 Normally use ROAP for these rides, which makes it run out even faster

- Work Release Program
- Special Events
 - AB Musicfest
 - Seafood Festival
- Carteret Community College (WIOA)
- Carteret Healthcare Hospital
- Sheltered Workshops
- Managed Heathcare System

Riding Process


- Schedule a day in advance
 - Between the hours of 7am and 10am
 - Call back between 3pm and 5pm to get Pick Up Time
 - Pay cash at time of ride or pre-load funds on a bus pass
- Rate we charge the funding source is not the rate clients pay




Riding Process

- Schedule multiple trips in advance
 - Take reservations any time into the future
 - As many trips as you like

Ride Demand by Hour*




Zone-based Fare System






Ridership by Funding Source
